#### August 2023 Luncheon – All about the Midway Museum

The summer GARA Luncheon was held August 30th on the patio at the The Heights Country Club in Rancho Bernardo – a great setting with a warm summer day to meet friends and enjoy great food. The speaker, Rob Sudman, an USAF Veteran and Docent for the Midway Museum, gave a very interesting summary of the history of the Midway Aircraft Carrier - from its commissioning in 1945 thru service in the Korean War, Vietnam War, the Cold War, as an artic test ship, as a flagship ship during the Kuwait/Iraq War and eventually being decommissioned and brought to San Diego by a group of civic leaders to be used as a Naval Carrier Museum.



Through the very hard work of many volunteers, the Midway Museum hosts millions of visitors from throughout the world and is the most successful Naval Air museum in the world. Rob also gave a preview of the next big project for the Midway Museum: the development of the Navy pier property, next to the Midway, into a public park dedicated to military veterans - "Freedom Park". This project will include the demolition of the derelict Navy storage building, turning the asphalt pier into an open to the public - free grass park with memorials honoring veterans, picnic areas, restrooms, snack bar and play areas for children. For those of you interested, there are volunteering opportunities - with some perks - on the Midway! The Midway Museum offers a discounted senior citizen yearly pass that allows you to bring your grandkids or visitors along for no extra charge (See Midway Web Site).

Father Joe's Villages mission is to prevent and end homelessness, one life at a time. # Retiree Benefits News from GA Human Resources

#### General Atomics 401(k) Retirement Savings Plan

Effective July, 2023, the General Atomics 401(k) Retirement Savings Plan transitioned service providers from Vanguard to Empower. All plan provisions, including investment options, remained the same so those with an account balance can register with Empower by visiting their website, <u>https://www.empowermyretirement.com</u>, or by calling them (877) 455-6204.

#### Pension Plan of General Atomics

Our pension plan administrator, Milliman, remains the same so any account and demographic information can be updated by visiting their website, <u>https://www.millimanbenefits.com</u>, or by calling them at (866) 767-1212.

#### General Atomics Retiree Medical Coverage

On Friday, September 29th, 2023, Scripps Health announced that, effective January 1st, 2024, Scripps Clinic and Scripps Coastal medical group doctors will no longer accept Medicare Advantage plans. General Atomics and our retiree benefits administrator, Mercer, reviewed this decision, consulted with UnitedHealthcare, and our collective understanding is that this will impact HMO plans only. The current UnitedHealthcare PPO plan offered to retirees will continue in 2024 and will be accepted by Scripps. We encourage our retirees to contact their primary care physicians and UnitedHealthcare to ensure their care will continue uninterrupted. 2024 open enrollment materials were mailed from Mercer on Monday, October 23<sup>rd</sup>, so they can be expected soon, if not received already. The General Atomics Retiree Service Center (GARSC) with Mercer can be reached at (855) 255-9093, available Monday through Friday from 5:30 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. (Pacific Time).

General Atomics group retiree medical coverage must be elected at the time of retirement, if eligibility requirements are met, in order to continue coverage. Retirees eligible for a General Atomics group retiree medical plan and enrolled in an

individual plan may be eligible for reimbursement of a portion of the premium and a separate mailing will be sent in December. Eligible retirees who do not elect a group retiree medical plan at the time of retirement will be unable to enroll in the future.

#### General Atomics Awarded Conceptual Design Contract Supporting Sandia National Laboratories

General Atomics Electromagnetic Systems (GA-EMS) announced an award from Sandia National Laboratories to provide design development services in support of a conceptual research reactor design for a new advanced facility. The concept design will facilitate the safe utilization, operation, and maintenance of the reactor and supporting systems.

"GA-EMS has a rich heritage and extensive expertise in the design, construction, installation, and on-going upgrades and support of a worldwide fleet of TRIGA® reactors," stated Scott Forney, president of GA-EMS. "We have long enjoyed a strong working relationship with Sandia and look forward to delivering a new facility conceptual contract to support their experimental, research and development activities going forward."

GA- has installed a variety of TRIGA reactor configurations in 68 facilities in 24 countries to support nuclear research, testing, and training activities at universities, government and industrial laboratories, and medical centers.

# GA-ASI to be Inducted into the International Air and Space Hall of Fame

General Atomics Aeronautical Systems, Inc. (GA-ASI) was inducted into International Air & Space Hall of Fame during an event at the San Diego Air & Space Museum on Saturday, Oct. 21, 2023. The Museum is honoring GA-ASI for its celebrated history of developing and implementing unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) that have supported worldwide security and defense for more than three decades. Poway, Calif.-based GA-ASI is renowned globally for its advanced remotely piloted aircraft systems, particularly the Predator® series which includes the advanced MQ-9A Reaper and MQ-9B SkyGuardian®. GA-ASI continues to innovate and enhance its UAS capabilities, expanding its product lineup to include additional variants and technology. The company's contributions to the field of unmanned systems have significantly impacted military operations and have paved the way for developments in civilian and commercial applications.

GA-ASI headlines this year's class of Hall of Fame inductees, which also includes William Shatner, Star Trek's Captain James T. Kirk; Royce Williams, American aviator and Navy Cross recipient; Robert DeLaurentis, record-setting American aviator; and Jessica Meir, distinguished NASA astronaut, biologist and a pivotal member of the groundbreaking Artemis program, which intends to land the first woman and next man on the moon. The San Diego Air & Space Museum, located at 2001 Pan American Plaza, Balboa Park, San Diego, CA 92101 will celebrate the inductees on Oct. 21 in the Edwin D. McKellar Pavilion of Flight. Guests from around the world will assemble for a spectacular evening of fun and extraordinary recognition, as each guest is treated to a behind-thescenes look into the lives of these true air and space legends.

Since 1963, the International Air & Space Hall of Fame has honored the world's most significant pilots, crew members, visionaries, inventors, industry-leading companies, aerospace engineers, aerospace industrialists, preservationists, designers and space explorers.
