Al Zimmer, Member at Large





Annual Dues Are Going Up

The annual dues fee has remained unchanged at \$10.00 for many years while the costs of producing and mailing the quarterly newsletter, and the fixed costs associated with luncheon have continued to increase with inflation. The last two years of the Covid pandemic have resulted in a significant spike in prices as most members must be aware.

Accordingly, effective March 1st, 2022, the GARA Board will increase the annual membership dues to \$15.00/year to cover increased costs.

Member payments for CY-2022 dues received before March 1, 2022 will be accepted for \$10.00.

Payments for CY-2022 dues received after March 1st or advance payments for 2023 and beyond must be in the amount of \$15.00/year.

Catch up payments for dues in arrears (2021 and earlier) will still be accepted at \$10/year.

In Memoria

GARA is deeply saddened to announce the passing of the following colleague:

Richard "Dick" McCormack September 6, 1931 - November 4, 2021

Dick passed away November 4, 2021 at his home in La Jolla of natural causes.

Dick attended Stevens Institute of Technology in Hoboken, New Jersey. After graduation, Dick joined the Navy as an officer. After 3 years in the Navy, Dick was hired as an engineer in Combustion Engineering's Manhattan office. In 1966, at age 35, he became the youngest vice president in CE history. Two years later, he transferred to CE headquarters in Connecticut and managed its nuclear power and fossil steam generator business. In 1974, he left CE to become president of General Atomic (GA) Power Systems Co. in La Jolla, California. After GA, Dick began a new career as a serial entrepreneur. Over the next 40 years, he started businesses associated with solar energy storage, publishing, sports videos, utility plant safety, software, consulting, green renovation of homes, hydrogen generation, and water desalination. Dick was active in the Catholic Church, his faith growing stronger as he aged.
